- * Applicants must be between the ages of 6 to 18 on **April 22, 2019**. She must also have a horse to ride, and enter at least one event in the Corning Jr. Rodeo. She must demonstrate her riding ability at Hospitality night on **May 31, 2019**.
- * Candidates are allowed to use only ONE horse throughout the competition. The contestants riding pattern will be posted at 12p.m. at the Corning Jr. Rodeo Arena on Hospitality Night.
- * Judging will be 1 to 15 points for personality, 1 to 25 points for horsemanship, 1 to 10 points for appearance and 1 to 50 points for ticket sales. Ties will be broken by the amount of tickets sold.
- * Candidates will be judged on personality, appearance and horsemanship. They will be expected to sell 100 or more pre-sale rodeo tickets.
- * Queen will be awarded with a Saddle, Silver Belt Buckle, Sash, Tiara and a Gift Certificate. All candidates will receive 10% of their ticket sales. **All Queen results and awards are final by Corning Jr. Rodeo committee.**
